'Happy and Married' was appalling. I'm sure the actors performed to the best of their abilities but the writing of the play was dire. Stereotypical depictions of clownish, stupidly good natured and babyish panish women are not my idea of contemporary theatre (nor are over-priviledged mummy's boys). As a woman whose family are of Catalonian origin and I was deeply offended by this show. We expected more of Northern Stage.

The performance was brilliant, the after-show discussion was very disappointing. Almost constant in-jokes between the director and male actor and their total failure to even attempt to answer a very harsh criticism from one audience member, amongst other things, made me wonder how on earth they managed to produce such a brilliant play.

I love that you are daring enough to show productions like this one. I have to confess I didn't understand a good deal of it, though. I also was not aware that it would be so short, but I may not have read it correctly. I think given that it was so short, a lower price may have been better, say £5 a ticket. I am generally a massive fan of the Northern Stage, though - well done!
